Reduce your speed when driving past the school.



Avoid parking on zig zag lines or double yellow lines.



Make sure you're not parked over a dropped curb.



Always double check for pedestrians or cyclists before starting to drive.

When trying to find a safe parking spot:

- consider local residents and ensure they have clear access to their property and the road.
- stay vigilant to vulnerable road users as they may step out into the road unexpectedly.
- avoid parking with two wheels on the pavement. This can obstruct wheelchairs and pushchairs.

You could face a fixed penalty notice if you're found to be illegally parked.
